**SNOWPLOW SAM 1-4:**

For beginners ages 3 to 5. These classes are designed to help our youngest skaters to develop the ABCs of movement — Agility, Balance, Coordination & speed. Classes are a safe and positive environment, incorporating fun & games, making class time an enjoyable experience for all. **\*Helmets REQUIRED for all Snowplow 1-4 skaters.** Must provide own helmet, as rink helmets are not available for use at this time.

**BASIC 1 - 6:**

For beginners ages 5 to 17. Six progressive levels that teach the FUNdamentals of ice skating & provides the best foundation for figure skating, hockey, and speedskating. Once the 6 levels have been completed, skaters will move on to Jr. Club. Skaters may choose to move on to LTP upon completion of Basic 1.

**ADULT 1-6:**

For ages 18 & up. The adult curriculum promotes physical fitness and improved balance & coordination, while teaching proper beginning skating techniques.

**HOCKEY 1-4:**

Proper skating techniques for the game of hockey are the primary focus. Skaters will learn the necessary fundamentals to be successful in hockey practices and skating game situations. (classes taught without a puck)

**Learn To Play (LTP) Hockey**

LTP will be offered on Tuesdays from 5:00-6:00PM. Class will be conducted on full ice and focus on improvement of power skating skills, stick and puck work, and game mechanics. Equipment rental is available for \$50.00 for the season; \$25.00 to be refunded when equipment is returned.



**Jr. Club**

ANIA's **Jr. Club** program offers an introduction to the beginning and intermediate elements of figure skating. This class is meant to prepare skaters to continue to advanced recreational skating, in addition to the U.S. Figure Skating beginning test structure and/or competitions. No matter your skating goals we'll help you get there!
