## Class Descriptions:

### SNOWPLOW SAM 1-4:

For beginners ages 3 to 5.

These classes are designed to help our youngest skaters to develop the ABCs of movement — Agility, Balance, Coordination & speed. Classes are a safe and positive environment, incorporating fun & games, making class time an enjoyable experience for all.

### BASIC 1 - 6:

For beginners ages 5 to 18.

Six progressive levels that teach the FUNdamentals of ice skating & provides the best foundation for figure skating, hockey, and speedskating. Once the 6 levels have been completed, skaters will move on to Jr. Club or LTP Hockey.

### ADULT 1-6:

For ages 18 & older.

The adult curriculum promotes physical fitness and improved balance & coordination, while teaching proper skating techniques.

### HOCKEY 1-4:

Proper skating techniques for the game of hockey are the primary focus. Skaters will learn the necessary fundamentals to be successful in hockey practices and skating game situations. (Taught without a puck)



## Learn To Play (LTP) Hockey

LTP will be offered on Fridays from 5:00-6:00PM. Class will be conducted on full ice and focus on improvement of power skating skills, stick and puck work, and game mechanics. Equipment rental is available for \$50.00 for the season; \$25.00 will be refunded when equipment is returned.

### Jr. Club

**Jr. Club** is designed to teach skills at a faster pace in a group lesson format. The program offers an introduction to the elements of figure skating and what is required if skaters choose to continue to skate recreationally, begin taking U.S. Figure Skating tests, and participate in competitions.
